High value definitive "Britannia"

Printed in **lithography** — Perf. 14 x 14 1/2

This high value definitive incorporates various notable security features:
Braille embossing (figure 10), use of metal and fluorescent inks, visible and invisible security fibres in the base paper stock, two elliptical perforations at the top and bottom of the stamp, OBA-free granite paper.
Britannia's shield is printed in (longwave yellowish) fluorescent ink.
